







Malta. Located in the south east of the island, between Marsamxett Harbour to the west and the Grand Harbour to the east. The metropolitan Valletta is the southernmost capital of Europe, and at just 0.8 square kilometres, it is the European Union's smallest capital city.

Valletta's 16th-century buildings were constructed by the Knights Hospitaller. The city is Baroque in character, with elements of Mannerist, Neo-Classical and Modern architecture, though the Second World War left major scars on the city, particularly the destruction of the Royal Opera House.

The city was officially recognised as a World Heritage Site by Unesco in 1980.



The architecture of Valletta's streets and piazzas ranges from mid-16th century Baroque to Modernism.





Malta's public transport system operates mostly on routes to or from Valletta.



The city's fortifications, consisting of bastions, curtains and cavaliers, along with the beauty of its Baroque palaces, gardens and churches.



Dotted with quaint cafés and wine bars, the city is today one of Malta's main tourist attractions, hosting among others, the majestic St John's Co- Cathedral, the imposing bastions and a treasure of priceless paintings.



The city's unique setting now plays host to a series of cultural events, from theatre in English, to concerts by leading opera singers.





The capital of Malta is inextricably linked to the history of the military and charitable Order of St John of Jerusalem. It was ruled successively by the Phoenicians, Greeks, Carthaginians, Romans, Byzantines, Arabs and the Order of the Knights of St John. Valletta's 320 monuments, all within an area of 55 ha, make it one of the most concentrated historic areas in the world.
